

Five Pieces of GOOD NEWS From August

- 1. A man met the woman he helped deliver on a San Francisco sidewalk. The birth happened on June 29th, 1988. At the time, he was walking to work when the woman began giving birth. He found the woman through a newspaper article and Facebook.
- 2. Robert Pope ran 134-miles (216 kilometres) to raise money for the World Wildlife Foundation. He is a ultra-marathon runner and ran with a pint of Guinness beer. The journey was the width of Ireland and he made it to Dublin in 23 hours and 39 minutes.
- 3. A sea turtle nest was found for the first time in Mississippi in 4 years.
 The eggs belong to either the loggerhead sea turtle or the rare Kemp's ridley sea turtle. Marine Mammal Studies protected the nest site. The waters were impacted by the 2010 Deepwater Horizon oil spill.
- 4. Georgia high school football players rescue woman trapped in a car.
 The six members used their strength to open the car door to get the woman out.

5. A 99-year-old Pennsylvania woman named Peggy Koller welcomed her 100th great-grandchild. Peggy is an only child who had 11 children and 56 grandchildren. Days after her 100th great-grandchildren, her 101st great-grandchildren were born.



Baked Pasta Recipe



Ingredients:

- 1 large carton of **cherry tomatoes** (700g)
- 1 block of **feta cheese** (400g)
- 4 Tablespoons olive oil
- 1 small onion
- 3 cloves garlic
- Pasta noodles
- Fresh **basil** (optional)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees
- In a 9x13 baking dish, place tomatoes, chopped onion and garlic.
- 3. **Drizzle** with olive oil and **mix**.
- 4. Place feta block in center of baking dish.
- 5. Bake for 40 minutes.
- 6. Cook pasta and drain it.
- 7. When tomatoes are done, **pour** cooked pasta into the baking dish and **mix well**.
- 8. Garnish with basil

Serves about 3-5 people
